### **SIMTABLE Gets** the Community Thinking about **Preparation**

Climate change is increasing the risk of bushfire throughout NSW. Hotter, drier conditions are producing more extreme fire danger days with Greater Sydney experiencing "catastrophic" fire conditions for the first-time last year.

Yet the community remains largely underprepared for bushfires and few residents have a survival plan.

At the community participation event held on the 8th November at Mangrove Mountain Hall, residents were able to work with a Simtable to explore how fires could affect their properties and the district.

The Simtable is a 3D interactive tool that projects an image onto a sand

Participants were able to shape the sand by hand to match the topography in the landscape projection. Images of the built environment and aerial photos were overlaid, creating the 3D effect, then weather, fuel and vegetation data were included to see the impact of extreme weather scenarios on their homes and neighbourhood.

Computer modelling is used to simulate a fire spreading from an ignition point and is very good at showing people the scale and extent of bushfire risk in an area, how far and how fast bushfires can travel, and why

they need to have a plan.

It's a great way of dispelling a lot of myths and assumptions that people can fight and stay and defend their homes in this terrain, in this situation. More people are lost trying to leave fires too late than while actually fighting fires.

The key is to have an early trigger to leave and to make sure that your home is quite resilient to bushfire. A wellprepared house has a far better chance of surviving bushfires.

Because it uses local maps, aerial photos and data, the Simtable provides residents with a highly realistic demonstration of how their properties and communities may be affected. The use of Simtable has the potential to provide attendees with a deep understanding of their risks, strengthen community connections and enable the development of tailored and detailed response plans.

The same process can be applied to floods and other scenarios.

The next community participation event on Wednesday 22nd November, 6pm to 7pm at Mangrove Mountain Hall, will be used to help residents prepare their own resilience and emergency plans and to decide how to best progress the development of a community resilience and emergency



### New Upgrade Funding For Central Coast Government Schools

Central Coast government schools can now apply for funding of at least \$250,000 to build or upgrade vital infrastructure.

Round 2 of the Federal Labor Government's Schools Upgrade Fund will provide \$215.8 million in funding and be targeted at schools with the greatest need.

This delivers on another election commitment from the Government. The grants can be used for large scale capital works projects such as:

- building or upgrading facilities, such as art facilities, music rooms, technical and applied studies facilities, sporting facilities.
- upgrading playground and outdoor learning facilities; and
- replacing ageing demountable buildings with permanent structures or modern modular teaching spaces.

This builds on the \$53.6 million in School Upgrade Funding the Federal Labor Government has already announced earlier this year for schools across the Central Coast.

Government schools on the Central Coast with the greatest need will be prioritised – including schools with high numbers of students from a low-socio economic background, First Nations Students, and students with disability and schools which haven't received significant capital funding in the last two years.

Central Coast schools can apply for funding at www.education.gov.au/schools-upgrade-fund.

Applications close 29 February 2024.

Dr Gordon Reid MP stated "Major upgrades for our Central Coast public schools will make a world of difference for students, improving not only their school environment but how they learn.

"I am very proud of our Central Coast schools and thank our teachers and support staff for all the work they do educating our next generations of Australians."

Minister for Education Jason Clare said "I want all students to get access to a quality education, including access to quality facilities to learn in and play on.



### Weed to Watch – Blue heliotrope

(Heliotropium amplexicaule)

Blue heliotrope is a drought tolerant and aggressive summer weed which has enabled it to persist and spread during these dry times. Its hardiness has made it a major agricultural weed in NSW. Blue heliotrope will out-compete desirable pasture plants and occupies over 110,000 hectares in NSW. It is



unpalatable to stock, but when it is eaten, it can cause liver damage, photosensitisation or sudden death in pigs, horses, cattle, sheep and goats.

It is also widespread and adaptable to a wide range of soil and climate types. Blue heliotrope is a native of South America and was probably introduced to Australia as an ornamental plant in the latter part of the 19th century. It was first reported in NSW in 1908 in the Hunter Valley.


