Democracy can be messy but it works

It has been said that the best form of government is a "Benevolent Dictatorship" where almost all power is in the hands of just one wise, fair and ethical person who will not be corrupted by the power and who will make all decisions in the best interests of the electorate. BUT, as such a person could be difficult to find, "Democracy" offers some safeguards.

The democratic process can be

complicated and frustrating but in most cases provides stability and predictability.

In the coming referendum, which is to be held at the same time as the Central Coast Council elections, the electorate will be asked to vote on a proposal to reduce the number of councillors from fifteen to nine, with a corresponding reduction on the number of wards from five to three.

One of the reasons given by the administrator is that fewer councillors would make it easier to reach consensus on issues at hand and that a larger number of councillors would lead to damaging conflicts.

The higher number of councillors will provide more opportunity for the

electorate to be heard.

According to the 2021 Census there are 346,596 people on the Central Coast with 263,967 over the age of 18. Fifteen councillors gives a ratio of about 18,000 voters to each councillor but a reduction to nine councillors increases this ratio to almost 30,000 voters to each councillor.

So a reduced number of councillors would make it much more difficult for any Central Coast resident or any of the multitude of Community Groups to be heard.

JUNE EXCURSION: A VISIT TO THE SLAB COTTAGES AT WRIGHTS CREEK

The Dharug & Lower Hawkesbury Historical Society invites you to join them on Saturday 29th June, to visit the slab cottages on the corner of Settlers and Wrights Creek road. From 1840, John Jurd and his descendants owned this property for the next 140 years. After the great flood of 1867, which inundated their first dwelling down on the river bank, the following year the Jurds built this new home high up out of reach of future floods.

One thinks of slab-built farm buildings as raw, crude, graceless and probably draughty. Yet this was a snug home with plastered interiors and elegant features. At either end it has two chimneys of fine ashlar stonework, and a scalloped cedar valance decorating the front of the veranda. It has a jerkinhead roof and an attic, which are most often seen in stone houses of the 1820s and 30s, but both are rare features in a slab building.


The current owner is beginning their restoration after decades of neglect. But the original elegance of these cottages is still apparent.



Simple, Natural Health Remedies

to 3, and councillors from 15 to 9. We urge people to vote "NO".



Show and tell included a striped camelia and cactus flower with two blossoms on 1 stem. A number of tree dahlia cuttings were brought to share. We also noted the passing of long time member and ardent gardener Beryl Collins.

Our guest speaker was Cathie Stubbs from Wildlife Carers Support and Education speaking about the diminishing variety of birds endemic to our suburbs and region as native plants are cleared or replaced by natives hosting large flocks of birds from western parts of the state. While noting the damage to flower and vegetable gardens by bush turkeys and lyrebirds, Cathie noted the good work they do in scratching, spreading seed, aerating the soil, etc. We watched a video segment on larger birds bullying smaller ones for a nesting spot and discussed the need for layers in gardens and parks – habitat shrubs for protection, spiky plants.



"Thanks for the lovely collection of knitted and crocheted items I picked up on Sunday.


I brought everything into work today and my volunteer Bev handed out several rugs and balls to our patients. Lots of smiles and warm thank you's from everyone."

Support for Living at Home

As many in our valley community know, I now find myself as a 24/7 carer for my wife, Judy, who has Alzheimer's Dementia. My name is Alan Smedley, and Judy and I have been residents on a property in Ravensdale for just under ten years, having moved here from the middle of Parramatta in a home that we renovated over many years and intended to be our forever home.

Judy is on a My Aged Care package, and although some local support is arranged for her in the form of cleaning and gardening, I have been trying to get local support workers to assist more with her care. Still, I was not successful, not for want of funding. In Judy's package, we have chosen the Self-Managed option and converted it to be managed by Homemade—a part of Mable—as the financial benefits to the care workers and us, with an added two percent fee, outweigh the benefits to anyone using a traditional service provider. Homemade manages the package, and Mable manages the care workers.

Living rurally, I don't think it's reasonable to expect that people who live twenty-five or forty kilometres away come here and provide the support that is needed when actually what we need can be done locally and with locals assisting one another, providing we do this in a way that is compliant around the regulations and rules of the My Aged

Care or NDIS package. Although there are locals who will willingly volunteer their time, I believe it is important to be able to provide some sort of remuneration or compensation as a thank-you gesture. Also, with an agency involved and formalizing this role it ensures there are no liability issues.

When the level of expertise required is greater than what the immediate community can muster, the ability to draw from a wider community, allows workers from further afield to travel and work in the valley seeing several clients throughout the day. It's a winwin situation.

After the meeting of 27th March in Yarramalong Hall, I continued to

investigate the model that can develop into a whole community benefit, something that Brad Grieve from Mable was very interested in looking into further with us, and I would appreciate getting replies from others who are interested in participating as recipients of care or as Care Workers.

This model needs a community structure for it to work, and Brad can explain this better than I can. Brad is also the person to explain with examples of rural communities in Australia who already benefit from this initiative because now they can employ local coordinator staff and fund activities that benefit the local community, instead of the package funding going to corporates with no interest in the local area.

Brad has also asked that if workers want to register on the day, they can bring a passport or birth certificate and three other forms of ID for the police check.

My concern, however, now that I have been on this path for well over six months, would be many instances where I feel we, as rural/remote residents, are not treated fairly or reasonably under the care packages that have been set in place.

With this in mind, we are organizing a follow-up meeting with Brad Grieve on the 25th of June at the Yarramalong School of Arts Hall where there will be an opportunity to see an opportunity for the community, ask questions and seek answer from 10.00 till 15.00.

Gosford Memorial Park to receive funding for Conservation Management Plan

The Gosford Memorial Park is one of 19 recipients across the state to receive a grant from the NSW Government from Round 2 of the 2023/24 Community War Memorials Fund, receiving \$10,000 for the preparation of a Conservation Management Plan.

Minister for Veterans, David Harris MP today announced the grants awarded to the successful applicants for projects that will support war memorials in communities across NSW.

"It is wonderful to announce this funding, which will be used for important projects around the state. Our communities are proud of their military history, and local war memorials are a vital part of our culture enabling us to reflect on over 100 years of our veterans' service and sacrifice." Mr Harris said.

Twenty-eight applications from

23 Local Government Areas were received for assessment during this round, which closed on 11 February.

"A total of \$150,496.65 was awarded to local councils, RSL sub-Branches and community groups, with grants ranging from \$2,000 to \$15,000 to fund conservation projects in 13 state electorates in both metropolitan and regional areas." Mr Harris added.

Member for Gosford, Liesl Tesch MP congratulated Central Coast Council for receiving the funding to assist in the preparation of a Conservation Management Plan for the Gosford Memorial Park.

"Our community today is thankful for the sacrifices made by current serving members and past servicemen and servicewomen and their families. We will never forget those who have served our nation. This grant funding will help to ensure that our war memorials continue to stand proud in our community as a reminder of the contributions made to our nation and its military history for years to come." Ms Tesch said.

Round 1 of the 2024/25 grant program is currently open and closes on 24 July 2024.

"I encourage any community group or ex-service organisation on the Central Coast to review the condition of our war memorials and to apply for funding for any conservation work that is needed." Ms Tesch added.
