"These websites are free one-stop shops for the motivation you need to get moving and improve you and your family's health.

"They include phone consultations with university-qualified health coaches that support everything from nutrition to pregnancy health."



Developed by Health NSW, Get Healthy offers six or more confidential coaching calls with a qualified health coach to support you to set and achieve your health goals, eat well and keep active, reduce the amount of alcohol you drink, keep a healthy weight in pregnancy, or stay active during and after cancer treatment.

Go4Fun is a free healthy lifestyle program for primary school children that offers 10 online sessions to learn skills to make healthier food, a reward program with tokens to collect, a weekly phone call from a personal coach and more activities for families.

AgSkilled extends cutting-edge program

The vital food producing areas of the Gosford electorate are set to benefit from an extension of the NSW Government's AgSkilled program.

The program can already count Central Coast farmers and ag workers among its success stories with 16 local students completing Drones in Agriculture training in 2024, while another eight are qualified in the Agricultural Chemical Skillset course.

Of the drone pilots, 83 per cent gained new skills needed for their jobs, while 17 per cent set up or expanded their own businesses.

"This brings cutting-edge knowledge to our region in a fast-changing industry, from mastering on-farm technology to improving safety, sustainability, and productivity," Member for Gosford Liesl Tesch said.

"The injection of a further \$5 million into Agskilled for another 12 months provides further opportunities

for Central Coast producers to get ahead."

Over the past year alone, AgSkilled has powered training for more than 2300 participants across 188 locations, achieving an impressive 94 per cent completion rate through 768 courses run by 33 endorsed providers, including TAFE NSW.

The program is also helping to attract a new generation to the sector, with one in four participants under 25, and one in four being female.

"Our local growers and producers are the backbone of not only the region but the national economy," Ms Tesch said.

"This funding will ensure TAFE NSW and other training providers can continue to deliver free or low-cost, industry-aligned training that helps regional economies grow now and into the future.

"This investment supports the next generation of farmers and producers to adopt sustainable and innovative practices, while also creating real career opportunities for people in regional NSW."

Somersby Corridor Included in Plans for Increased Residential Density Development

Business NSW Central Coast, in conjunction with Prometheus Planning and Milestone-Belanova has produced the Central Coast Residential Development Guide, a guideline for residential development with practical information relevant to development in areas like Gosford, Tuggerah, Wyong,

Woy Woy, and the benefits of including affordable housing in new projects.

The Central Coast has a population of over 351,000 and growing, who enjoy a high quality of life between the greater metropolises of Sydney and Newcastle.

This makes the Central Coast an attractive and secure longterm investment location for residential developers

The housing crisis has created unprecedented demand for new homes on the Central Coast. It's not just about growing businesses needing to accommodate new staff - frontline workers such as nurses, paramedics, police and hospitality employees are also in the market for affordable, well-located homes.

Over the last couple of years, the Central Coast recorded over \$1.6 billion in residential development approvals, with an average of four new houses being approved every day. This growth is expected to be sustained over the coming decades.

Investments over \$10 million in Gosford City Centre are assessed by the State Government under a designled approach to planning controls.

There is an urgent need to accelerate housing development around the major transport hubs in Wyong, Tuggerah, Gosford, and Woy Woy. These areas have the potential to deliver muchneeded affordable housing and greater diversity across medium to high density housing choices.

The Central Coast economy is set to almost double to an annual Gross Regional Product of \$35B by 2040, driven by booming sectors like health, education, and advanced manufacturing.

With rental vacancy rates between 0.6 per cent and 1.5 per cent, and a 36 per cent rise in median housing prices from 2018 to 2023, the demand for new housing is undeniable.

There is also a critical shortage of affordable housing for essential workers that are so critical to the health and growth of local communities.




The regional plan has a mix of density targets across different community contexts, from new greenfield developments to metropolitan city centres, to be met through a diversity of human scale housing types up to four stories.





Gosford Library Saved

Gosford library has been saved from the threat of demolition, with the Central Coast Council recently voting to retain rather than raze this significant Modern building.

Central Coast locals have rallied to save the Gosford Library since demolition was proposed, with ongoing petitions, letters and community advocacy reflecting the sustained community investment in this significant place. The National Trust has engaged with the Central Coast Council on several occasions, recommending that the Gosford Library building is suitable for adaptive re-use and noting that this would be the best possible environmental and cultural outcome in response to the evolving landscape of the Gosford CBD.

The National Trust commends the Central Coast Council for retaining this significant building – a place important to the accessibility of education in NSW and a unique architectural gem for Gosford – and the group of concerned locals whose efforts have led to a positive heritage outcome.




