My View On Rural Planning

A response to recent regional development and conservation plans

This is part of an insight into the development of rural lands on the Central Coast NSW plateau and valleys by Gordon Monro, Somersby.

The State proposed E4 zones and those areas earmarked for development in the recent Central Coast Regional Plan 2041 have direction by the Government for Council to prepare more studies. These may take years to consider and possibly untold years to implement .

There may be more definitions to analyse and comprehend. More appeals and delays and there will be more winners pitted against losers in these studies. There will be more land speculation driving up prices.

In the meanwhile we are left with the thousands of pages of definitions zones, living styles, dwelling requirements and land ownership tenure types all with separate regulations to wade through. And no additional provision for increased rural housing.

The current provisions in legislation that allow additional buildings include:

- Dwellings
- Secondary dwellings
- Rural workers dwellings but not in conjunction with secondary dwellings.
- Farm stay accommodation of 5 bedrooms which can be in separate buildings.
- Farm experience premises available on a commercial farm.

Many of these outdated planning options serve no real function in providing significant additional housing and are only available to a limited few properties.

However, if priority is given to developing on less viable parts of agricultural land and the requirements of access, and water and sewer are provided and preservation of environmental lands are complied with, then additional dwellings can be incorporated over the whole of the Rural lands now by amending the CCC Development Control Plan (DCP).

This will allow for additional rural lots or housing on all existing farms with eco-friendly water and sewer services implemented which preserves much of the city's dwindling water supply and at a fraction of the cost of Council urban schemes. (details are available) Amendments to local regulations can be made to limit the maximum number of new dwellings or percentage of new lots based on the property area. Areas developed can be as low as 5% of the farm area for larger properties with 95% of the farm being preserved indefinitely for farming and agricultural use. A slight reduction of the farm areas will provide much needed individual dwelling sites taking up no more room than multiple buildings of different roles as is already

In an allocation of 5% of a 20ha. farm there can be 4>5 lots @1500-2500m2 per lot or dwelling site. This can result in a few thousand sites being immediately available on the 3400 properties on the plateau and valleys.

In reality, there is no real need for housing to be located on a new separate lot if the property owner proposes to rent the new dwellings or use it for short term stay or to provide for workers on the farm. Why, for example, have farm stay limited to 50% of the year or less and leave the buildings vacant for the

rest of the year?

Who really cares and does it really matter whether the dwelling is defined as, or used for, 'lifestyle living, farm stay accommodation, community development, aged housing or a rural workers dwelling? If property owners wish to have a community or other title then that can still be incorporated within the existing requirements.

It is well past time to get rural planning back to reality and prevent trading our agricultural future and lifestyle for quick profits that benefit a select few by earmarking specific parcels of land for bulk development as envisaged in the Central Coast Regional Plan 2041.

Marilyn Steiner, a passionate entomologist, devoted gardener, and one of my dearest friends, passed away peacefully on 24 October 2025, surrounded by love, showing the same courage in passing that marked her life.

Born in England, Marilyn studied Applied Biology at the University of Bath, specialising in crop protection. Her career took her to Canada and later Australia, where she met and married fellow entomologist Dr Stephen Goodwin. Together, they made lasting contributions to sustainable horticulture, developing natural enemies for pest control now used worldwide.

Marilyn and Stephen lived at Mangrove Mountain, where they developed a garden akin to an extensive botanical garden and advocated for environmental causes, including campaigns against coal seam gas exploration and landfill expansion. When Stephen's health declined, they moved to the Southern Highlands. After Stephen's passing, Marilyn continued to lovingly reshape their garden and proudly opened it this year as part of the local garden club—a personal triumph.

Marilyn was one of my closest and most loyal friends, always in my corner; attending nearly all of my concerts. In my peach-farming days, Marilyn (and Stephen) not only helped in the orchard but transformed the harvest into cakes and peach schnapps. My children always considered her part of our family. Her dogs and cats, (and the birds that she fed) were constant companions.

Marilyn passed away courageously, peacefully at home, overlooking her beloved garden, with me, her stepdaughter Alison, and Patsy (End of Life Angels) by her side. She will be deeply missed for her intelligence, humour, kindness, and unwavering generosity.



She leaves behind her three siblings, especially David and wife Mary with whom she was incredibly close; step-children Alison and Nicholas and step-grandchildren Isabelle, Finn, Lachlan, Tye and Charlotte; and the many friends she has taken with her through life.



Hazardous waste disposal & container collection

Common household items, such as used batteries, gas bottles, and leftover paint and chemicals, can pose serious risks to people, animals, and the environment if not disposed of properly.

They can now be disposed of through Community Recycling Centres and at Household Chemical CleanOut events across the state. Always store and transport household chemicals safely, never mix chemicals, and wherever possible, keep all chemicals in their original containers.

Ensure containers are clearly labelled and well-sealed. If you do not know the contents, label the container 'unknown chemical'. Liquid can leak during transport. To prevent this, wrap containers holding liquids securely in newspaper, place them in sturdy plastic bags, and then in plastic buckets or trays.



In addition, if you need to dispose of empty chemical drums, use the drumMUSTER interactive map to locate your nearest drumMUSTER collection site.

Before bringing your chemical containers to a drumMUSTER

collection point, make sure to triple rinse them to remove any chemical residue.

After rinsing, remove the lids and allow the containers to dry completely. Since lids can't be recycled, dispose of them responsibly. It's also important to ensure your containers meet the program's criteria—clean, free from contamination, and displaying the eligible drumMUSTER logo.
