**Farm kids standing guard against bushfire, pests, drought and flood.**

The challenges farming families face when dealing with the impacts of bushfire, pests, drought and flood have an enormous effect on our rural communities.

In these times it is our children who can feel like they are uninformed and

unheard.

The 'Farm Force' program provides our kids from the Hunter region a chance to have a voice.

It will see the creation of a series of books addressing these issues that are written and illustrated by local kids, to be used as a resource for the local community.

Hunter LLS Community Engagement Officer Daniel Trudgeon said the first of the book series will focus on local experiences of the 2019/2020 bushfire season.

"Last summer's bushfires were the most severe on record as they affected so many parts of our region and across NSW," said Daniel.

# Club Grants Deliver Boost for Local Communities

Communities across the State will benefit from the NSW Government's latest round of Infrastructure Grants Program, with more than \$4 million awarded for 26 projects.

Minister for Customer Service Victor Dominello said the funding covered projects across sport and recreation, arts and culture, disaster readiness and essential community infrastructure.

"This funding is a big win for grassroots organisations, who are often the lifeblood of a community," Mr Dominello said.

"The \$12.5 million yearly program is aimed at funding projects to build or upgrade community facilities, and this round gave special consideration for projects to repair and rebuild community assets affected by bushfires.

"By expanding the funding criteria, these grants will help revive local communities as they recover from the devastating bushfires and COVID-19.

"The projects will help restore a sense of community by boosting participation in sports; encouraging active engagement in local theatres, creative arts and museums; and helping communities recover and prepare for future challenges."

Since 2015, the NSW Government has funded more than 350 community projects worth \$62 million under the Infrastructure Grants program.

Some of the funded projects are:

**Arts & Culture: \$50,000 to \$200,000 available per project**  
**Dorrigo (Northern Tablelands): Redevelopment of the Old Gazette Theatre - \$200,000**

The renovation and expansion of the foyer of Dorrigos Old Gazette Theatre will provide access to all community members regardless of mobility, for all events. The extension of the foyer space, all-access amenities, an upgraded food service facility, and climate-controlled space will attract a broader range of users and enhance the experience for all patrons.

**Disaster Readiness: \$10,000 to \$200,000 available per project**  
**Black Head (NSW Mid North Coast): Upgrade of the Black Head Surf Club - \$199,874**

The upgrade to Black Head SLSC

will enable the facility to become an emergency evacuation centre for the Manning Valley region, maximising community safety.

Works include installation of water tanks, security system and external lighting, solar power and fire protection measures surround the perimeter of the club as advised by the Local Emergency Management Officer.

**Nymboida (NSW Northern Rivers): Upgrade of the Big Shed - \$200,000**

The upgrade of the Big Shed provides a disaster ready, stand-alone community facility incorporating a professional kitchen, independent power, reliable, clean water source and emergency communication. These crucial services will be used in emergency situations by the community and emergency personnel. Into the future, the Nymboida community will have a safe accessible recreation place to meet, relax and connect.

**Community Infrastructure: \$10,000 to \$200,000 available per project**  
**Tuncurry (NSW Mid North Coast): Installation of community solar system project - \$88,457**

The project will install a 40-kilowatt hybrid solar system with battery storage at the Waste Transfer Station to supply the Forster Tuncurry Men's Shed and adjacent site holders at Tuncurry Community Recycling Centre. The batteries will enable the

- The development of an Aviation Hub at Central Coast Airport

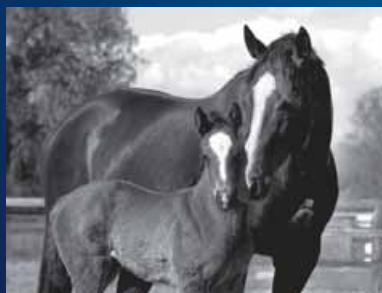

# Tree Lucerne benefits for farms & rural properties

Tagasaste or tree lucerne (*Chamaecytisus palmensis*, *Chamaecytisus proliferus*, *Cystisus proliferus*), is a small evergreen tree that grows 3-6m high and is a popular plant for people looking to regenerate poor soils and feed livestock.

It is indigenous to the dry volcanic slopes of the Canary Islands and was introduced to Australia some time around 1879 when seeds were sent from the Royal Botanic Gardens, Kew, England to the Adelaide Botanic Gardens.

In its native habitat, tagasaste has long been used for animal fodder. In Australia it has been planted around homesteads for windbreak and decorative purposes and shade in fowl yards and sometimes used for fodder. Tagasaste, being an evergreen, can provide green feed at any time of

palatability and high protein content. It can be grazed directly, or cut and fed fresh or dried.

As a fodder crop tagasaste delivers about 25 % crude protein and about 20% crude indigestible fibre. With proper application of fertiliser it can maintain these levels even when grown on poor soils.

Tagasaste typically has the same nutritional value as the best type of lucerne when planted on good soil balanced in nutrients.

Flowering changes the palatability of tagasaste. In plants that have not flowered, the leaves will be grazed and bark on the stems ignored. After flowering the leaf becomes less palatable and the bark more palatable. This results in stock stripping bark off the trunk.

Trials have shown that if tagasaste is heavily grazed or harvested in the first six months of the year, it will not flower in the second half of the year so preventing the taste change.

High phenolic levels after flowering can inhibit rumen function and cause protein shortages so animals respond

Tagasaste is a deep rooted perennial (at least 10m) that can bring nutrients from deeper in the soil up to the surface for other crops with shallower roots.

Tagasaste does not like “wet feet” and good drainage for the root system is a must.

## Irrigation

Tagasaste plants are remarkably drought resistant. Initial watering to aid establishment is beneficial. Ongoing drip irrigation, microsprays or similar may provide ongoing productivity improvement.

## Planting time

For both direct drilling and transplanting, late winter is suggested for lower-rainfall areas and early to mid spring for higher-rainfall tableland areas. In regions of reliable autumn rains or with access to irrigation, early autumn is a good time. Small seedlings are susceptible to heavy frosts.

Tagasaste can be grown in rows, or even as a hedge or in companion with other crops.

## Mechanical harvesting

Closely planted rows can be mechanically harvested. With trees spaced further apart and large enough to resist damage by grazing animals, they can be pruned, and the prunings grazed where they fall.

## Productivity & Carbon

It has been found that tagasaste can sequester carbon at the rate of about 6 tonnes CO<sub>2</sub> equivalent per hectare per year. About half the CO<sub>2</sub> being stored is as organic carbon in the soil and half is in the wood of the branches, trunk and roots. Tagasaste typically yields roughly 1 tonne of edible material per 100mm of rain per hectare per year.

## Plant description

- Plant: A tall perennial legume shrub with very deep root system
- Stems: Can grow into a tree form but is managed for a low shrub with multiple stem branching from just above the soil surface.
- Leaves: Multiple narrow leaflets (5 to 30 mm) long, emerging from a common petiole.
- Flowers: Small white pea flowers
- Pods: Narrow pods with about 10 seeds per pod.
- Seeds: Hard seeded

## Fodder

Tagasaste is a valued forage for ruminants because of its good

to protein supplements at this time.

## Bee forage

Tagasaste can begin flowering in its second year, and provide valuable nectar and honey in early spring when many bee colonies are hardpressed for forage. If colonies are able to increase, many field and horticultural crops will benefit from improved pollination, provided bees are not then diverted by the tagasaste.

## Soil improvement

Tagasaste is also a well-known “fertilizer tree”. As a member of the legume family, it is a nitrogen fixer: it captures nitrogen from the air and puts it in the soil through the roots via rhizobium bacteria and falling leaves.

## Update on Kariong Recycling Facility

The Kariong Sand and Soil Supplies development, proposed for 90 Gindurra Rd, Somersby, is located on the eastern side of the Somersby Industrial Estate.

Development approval is being sought to turn the site into a best practice recycling facility for the Central Coast, creating at least 20 new jobs at the site and many more in the surrounding areas due to the flow-on effect. This will inject more than \$407 million in the local economy over the next 25 years.

The original development application was issued for public comment by the Department of Planning and Environment between February and March 2019. The Davis family, owners of the site, have reviewed these comments in detail and an updated application has been submitted to demonstrate how the development will be built and operated to protect the community and the environment, whilst creating jobs and supporting the Central Coast economy.

To address community feedback on the project, Kariong Sand & Soil Supplies are proposing additional site upgrades to ensure that no impacts will occur on the environment or the community.

This includes: a building to enclose recycling operations to minimise

dust and noise; a building around the waste receival area to ensure that water quality is protected and dust is minimised; an advanced water recycling and dust suppression system; concrete kerbing on the exit to the site to prevent any trucks using Debenham Rd; further investigations to ensure that Aboriginal Heritage and biodiversity impacts are avoided or off-set; a commitment that recycling will increase in stages, only after independent testing is done to prove the facility is performing to the highest environmental standards.

Mr Eric Davis, CEO of Davis Earthmoving & Quarrying said "Our development application has been updated to reflect these changes after we ran many public meetings and field days to listen the community."

"We believe the project is one of the best recycling projects of this

type in Australia, helping to create jobs and a sustainable environment on the Central Coast. By recycling, we avoid the need for new landfills, and recycled materials can be used in building and landscaping. This avoids the need to extract these materials from the natural environment" said Mr Davis.

Mr Davis added, "The population of the Central Coast is forecast to grow by up to 20% by 2036, resulting in a 26% increase in residential development, and this facility will help recycle materials from all this building work."

The NSW Government has set ambitious targets to reduce the amount of building waste going to landfill with recycling targets of 80% by 2021. The facility will also provide competitive options for local companies who currently have limited

## 'Our Site' made by and for women

Women With Disabilities Australia (WWDA) have recently launched 'Our Site', a website dedicated to information about woman with disabilities.

Made by women, for women, the site includes resources and information for all women with disability over the age of 15.

Liesl Tesch MP, Member for Gosford says this is a huge step in the right direction.

"Every person with a disability struggles with different issues and overcomes different hurdles but a lot of overlapping issues experienced by women are often drowned out in the conversation," Ms Tesch said.

"It's clear there's even a gender gap in the disability sector with women making up less than 39% of people being supported by the National Disability Insurance Scheme."

Our Site has information on women's rights, leading and taking part in activities, life choices, safety and violence advice, body talk and real stories from women with disability, providing guidance through many lived experiences.

Ms Tesch says having someone to relate to is a helpful step on the road to better living.

"Women with disability don't have

to go through these experiences alone, however these stories are both heartbreaking and heart-warming at the same time, revealing that there is still a lot of education to do."

"Heartbreaking because it's devastating to read about what these incredible women have had to endure and heart-warming because there is a light at the end of the tunnel and these stories will help other women realise that too."

Despite the need, the NSW Government planned to cut disability advocacy funding in July 2018 but as a result of community campaigning the Government extended the funding to December 2020.

There is no guarantee the funding will be delivered in 2021 and beyond leaving disability advocacy organisations, which are already underfunded, in even more precarious situations.

Ms Tesch says she's thankful Our Site has been established given the uncertain future of disability advocacy.

"Having wrap around support and advocacy services for disability is crucial for our community and something that is clearly undervalued by the Berejiklian Government."

"In the absence of a certain future for disability advocacy in our state I'm so thankful 'Our Site' is up and running, trying to fill a gap that may unfortunately soon present itself."

"Despite this I really do hope the NSW Government guarantees disability advocacy funding into the closely approaching New Year to give us all some peace of mind and services we deserve."
